As a part of the CSA (Social Work) session on constitution and citizenry, the students of class 8 discussed about the right to health.

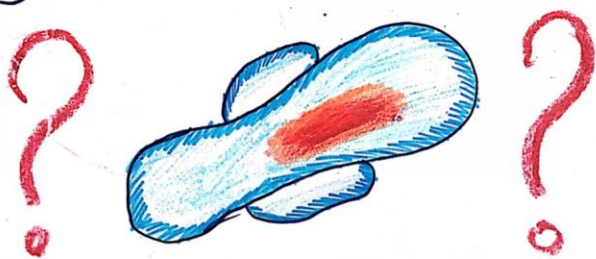

The questions they have raised to the government shows what they think about the it's misplaced priorities. Some of the posters reflect that young girls see this imposition as a state assault on bodies. While even tax on luxury cars have gone down the government is still defending this rate suing the raw materials are expensive.
