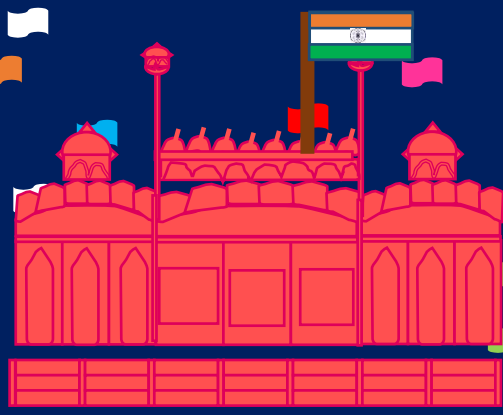

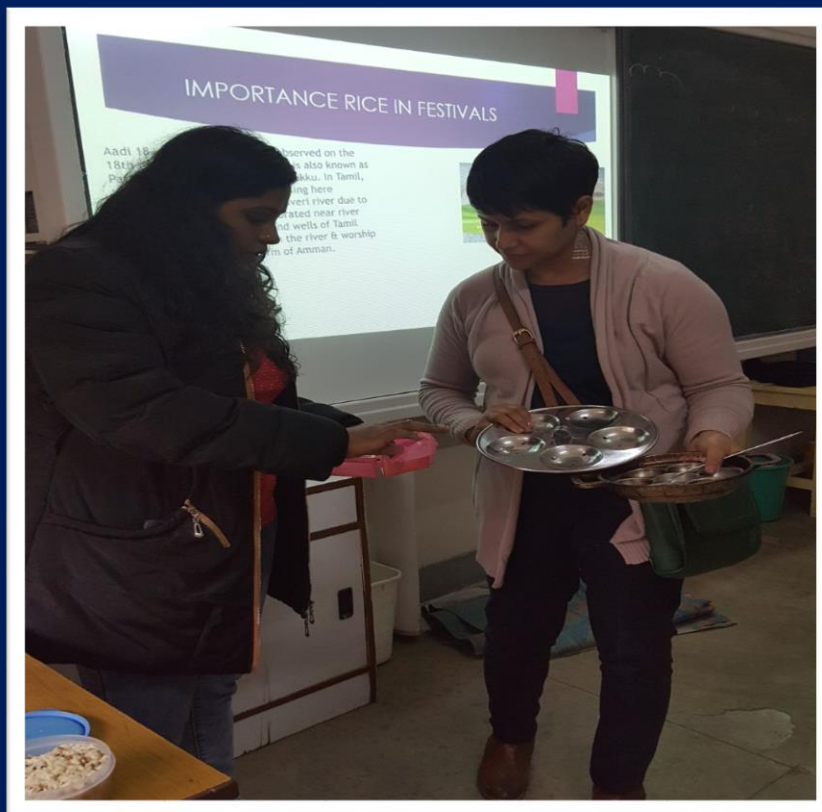

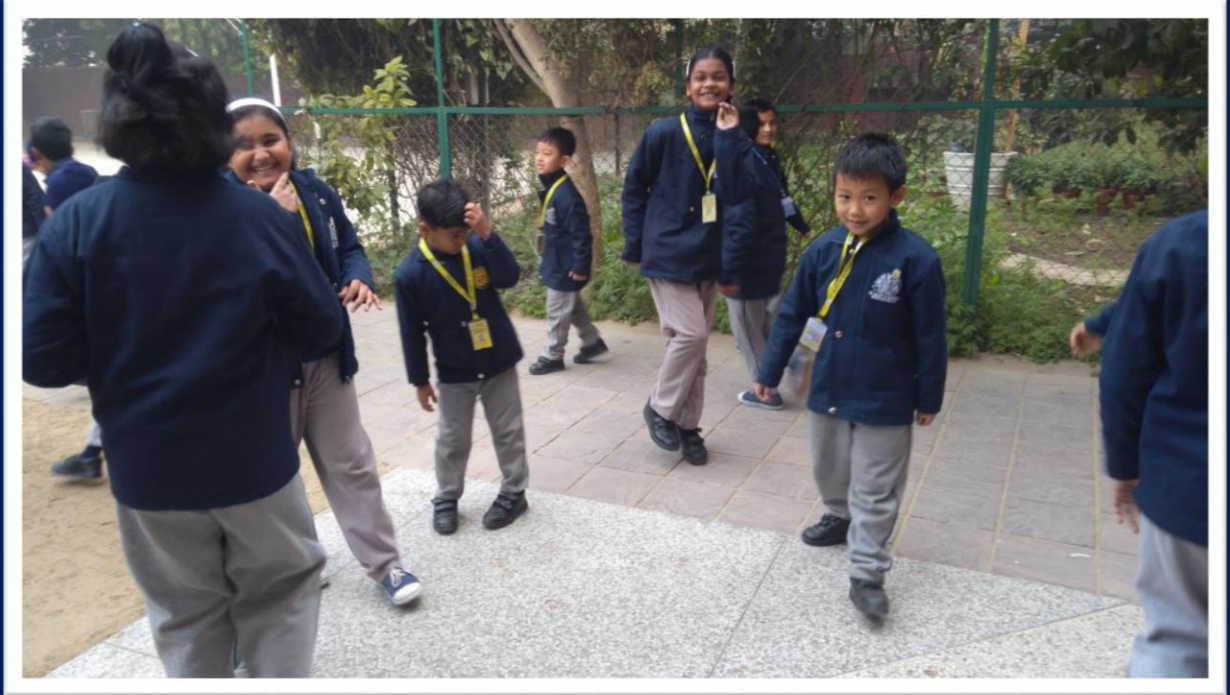
Club activities
