BON APPETITE

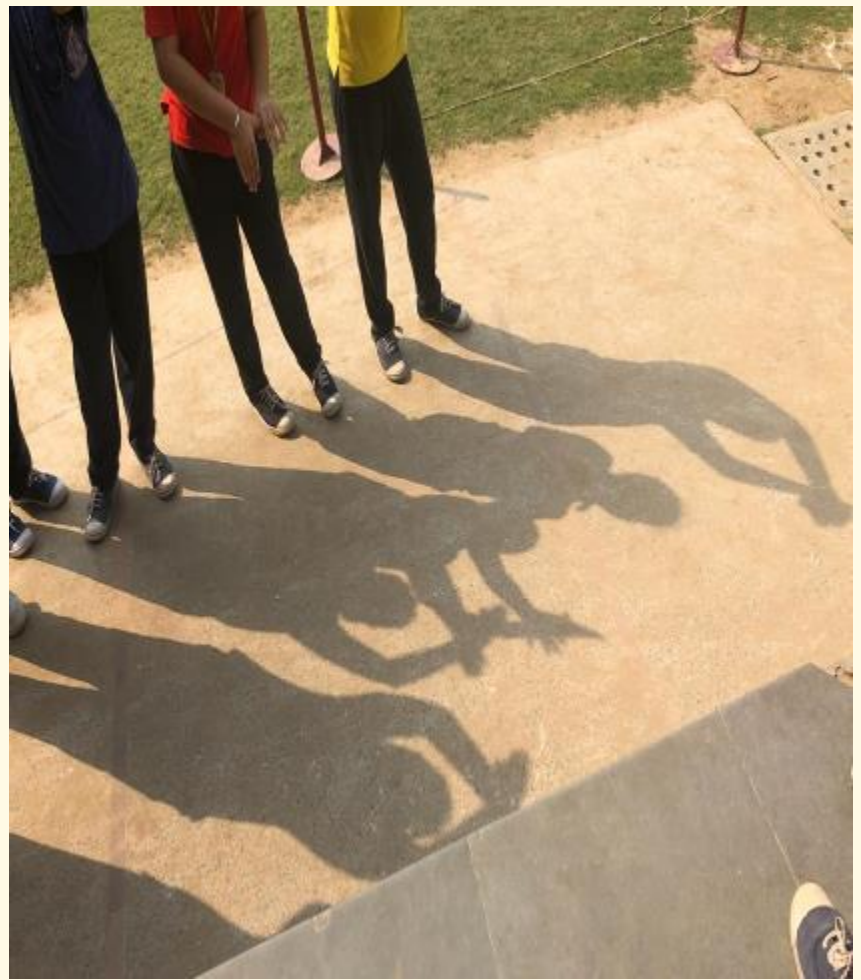
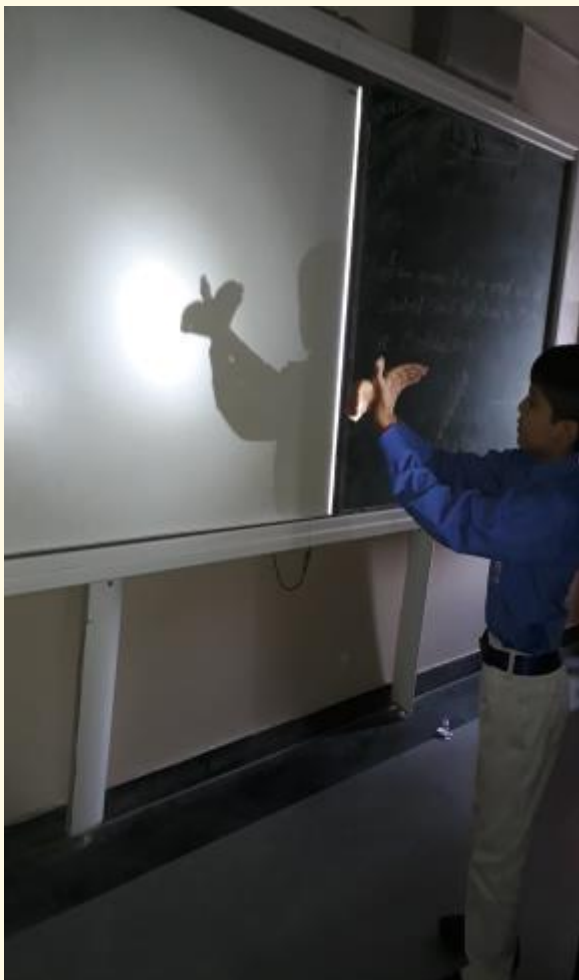

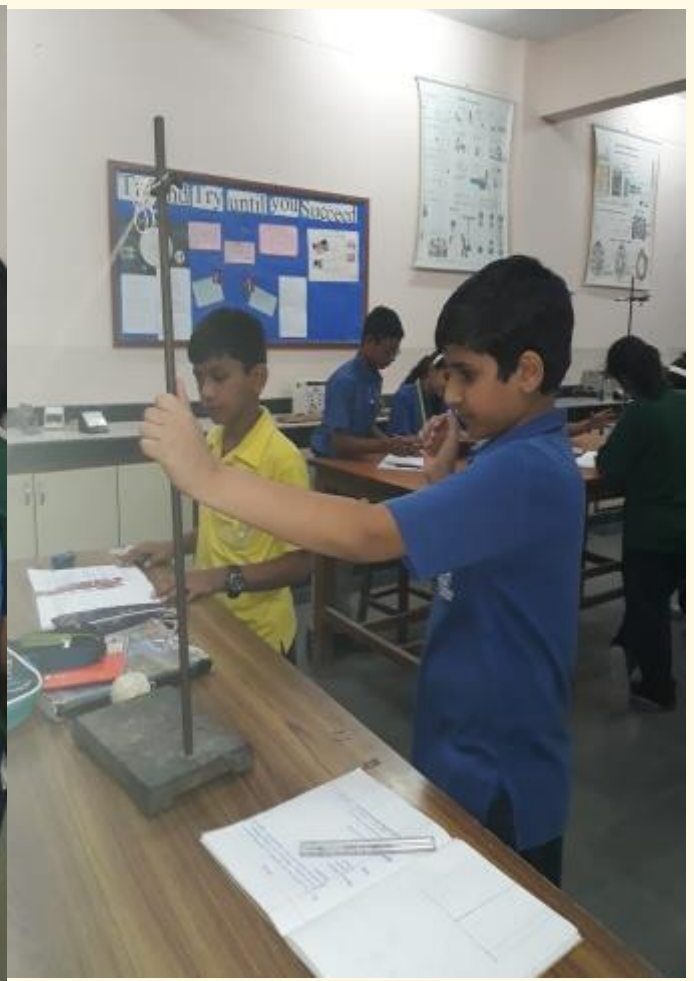
FUN WITH SHADOWS

WALLS

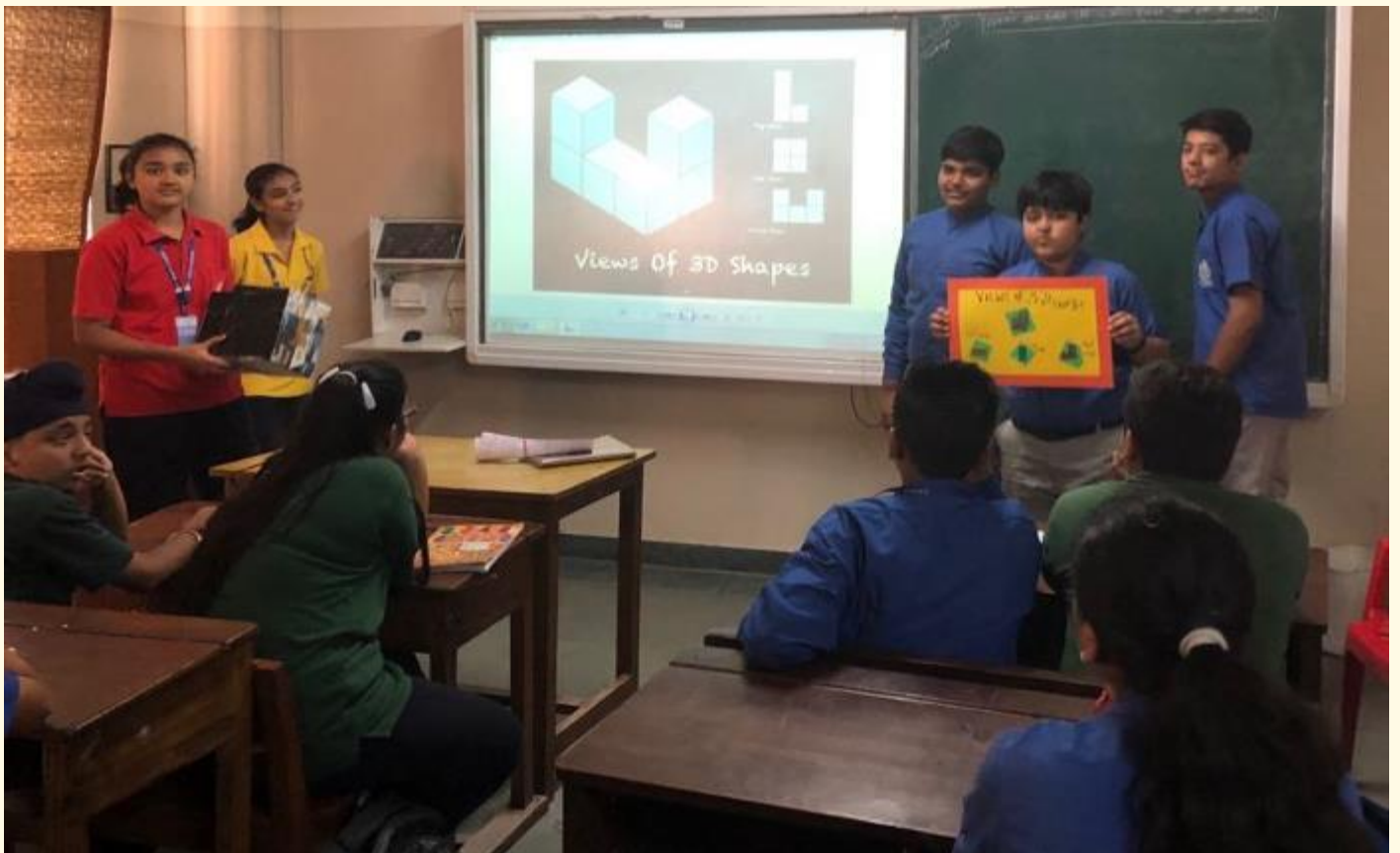
