Children, PRA and reflections

"...we realised people were active in taking about their community"-Shivam

"people know about their community more than us because they won it... therefore they should be consulted rather then we deciding what they eat."-Sabih

"..we came to realise that aunty's maps are different form uncle's maps and children's map of the community again is very different." -Shalini

Transect Walk
