Guru Nanak Dev Ji

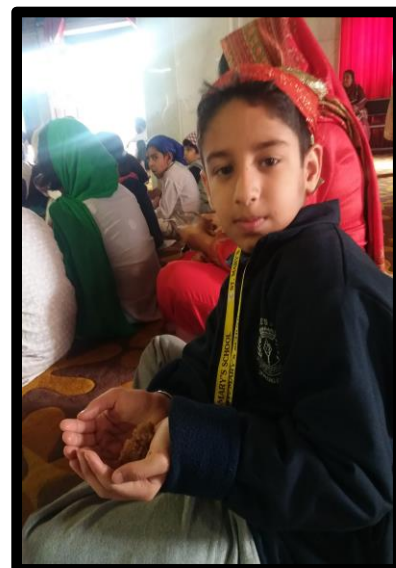

After the sumptuous meal they bowed to the holy Guru Granth Sahib and were eager to get back to school.

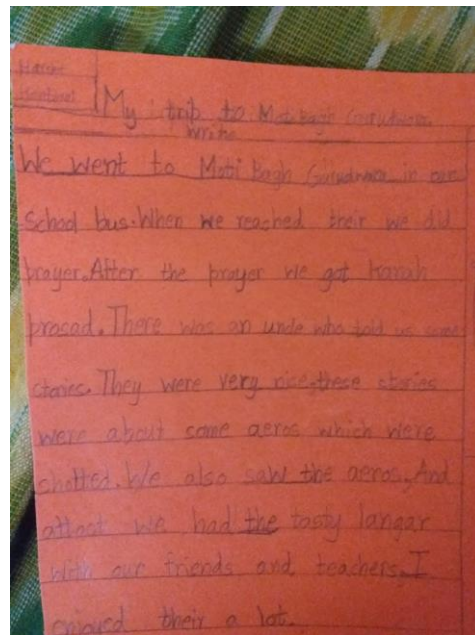
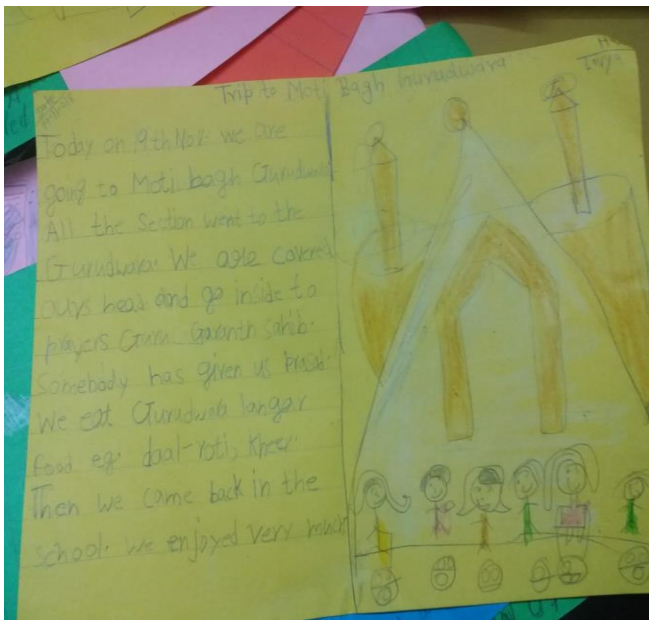


After coming back children shared their experiences and spoke about how it is different as well as similar to their place of worship.
