

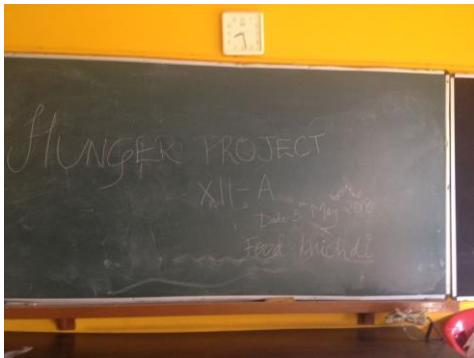
# HUNGER PROJECT XII-A
