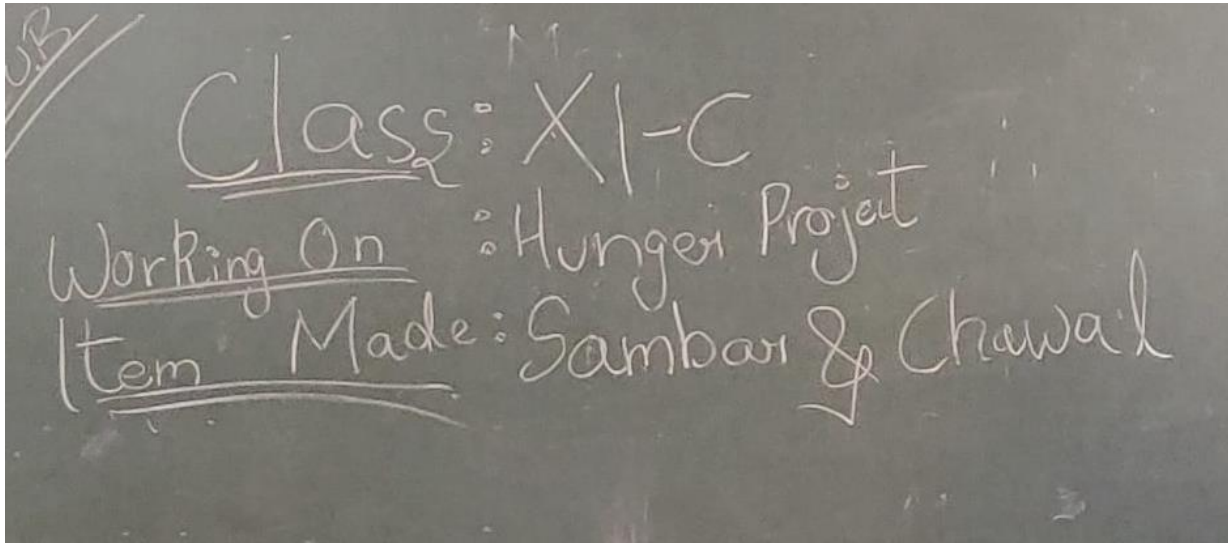


HUNGER PROJECT
