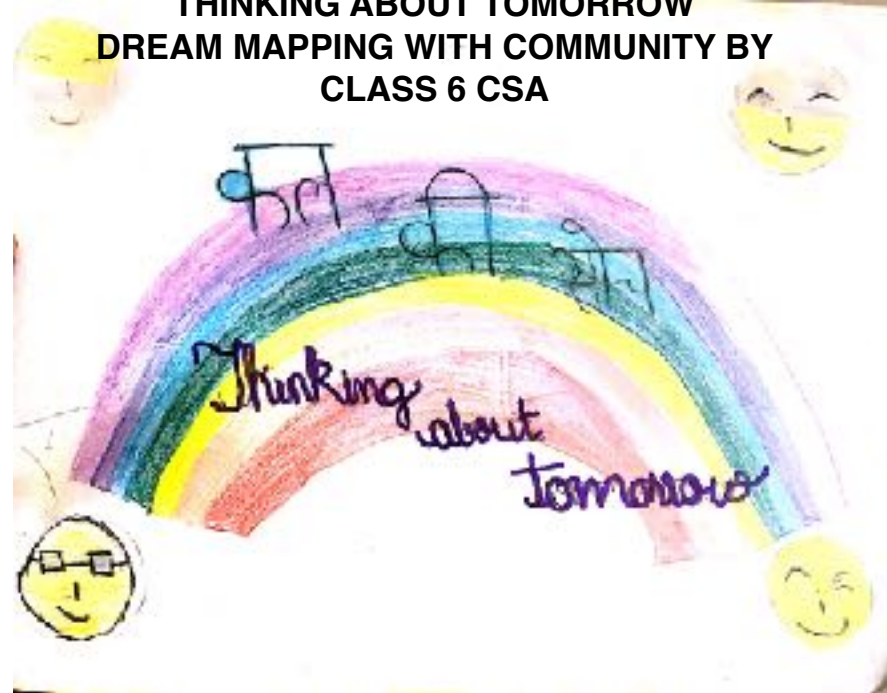


**KAL KI SOCH

CLASS 6 CSA**



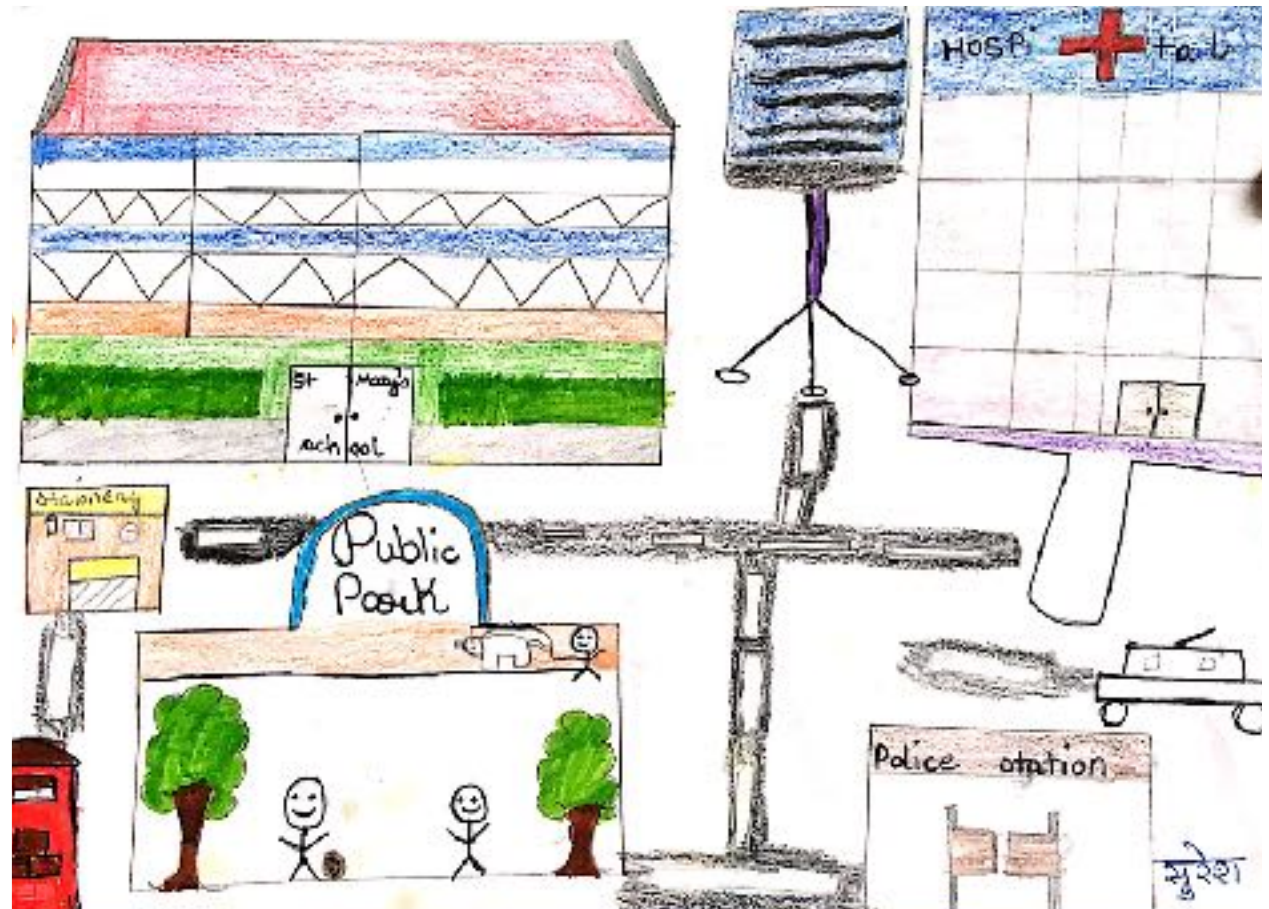

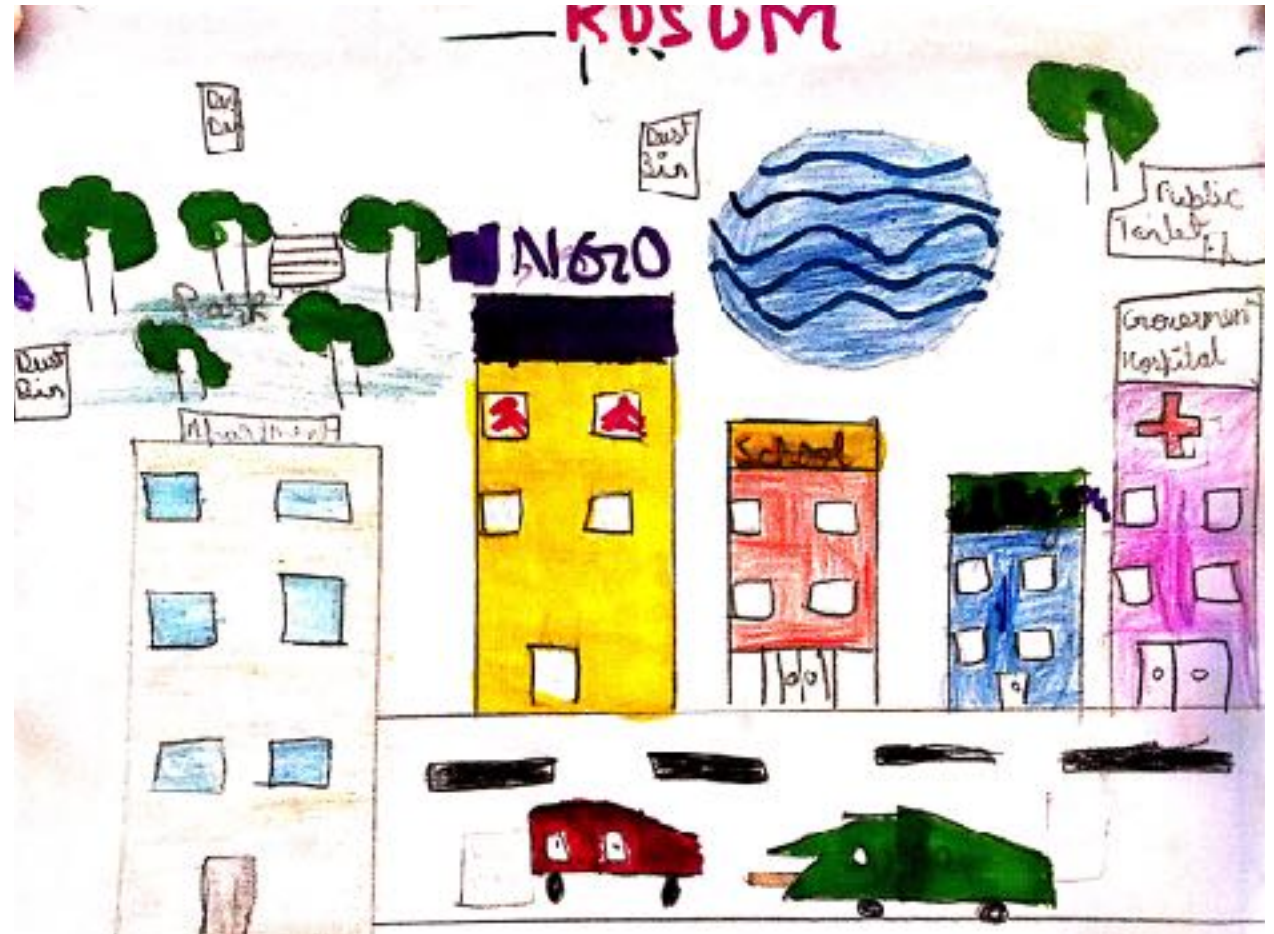
